Compare objective percentages to baseline data to assess ambitious yet attainable levels via reviewing required and permissible services.

Session #4: Project Design & Delivery of Services 8:30 am - 9:45 am

Improve the quality and impact of your Project through a discussion of program design; staff structure; methods to identify, recruit, and select Participants; and service delivery plans.

Examine methods to evaluate services and activities and their appropriateness to Project objectives; assess progress toward meeting objectives (formative); and measure success in achieving objectives at the end of the Project year (summative).
